1. SUMMARY DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED ACTIVITIES FOR 2011

1.1. Research

Line 1. The implementation (or lack) of the Rule of Law: public security or insecurity?

- **L1.1. Violence and Frontiers:** Research goals: a) analysis of data from the National Report on Human Rights for Rondônia and Acre, for the period 2000 to 2009 with focus on political representation and data on violent crimes, in particular homicide; b) publication of two papers; c) organization of four seminars on the project; d) research report with the main results achieved in the years 2009 and 2010 edited and disseminated at NEV's website.

Line 2. Public security, police performance and democratic political culture – the preconditions for a Human Rights Culture

- **L2.1. Police investigation and judicial process in São Paulo:** the case of homicides: Research goals: a) completion of qualitative analysis of court and police documents ; b) organization of archival data collected and collection of supplementary archival data and interviews with members of the criminal justice system if needed; c) analysis of the data and preparation of the final report. This report is the basis for the organization of a book on criminal impunity and trust in the police and in the criminal justice system. The analysis of the role that different institutions of the criminal justice system play in investigations, in the respect for rule of law to produce punishment will be fundamental to answer some questions posed by the research program.

The time of justice: its impact in the production of penal impunity: Research goal: develop "time tables", apply them to cases entered in the database and extract results. Results will complement the analysis of the project "Police investigation and judicial process in São Paulo: the case of homicides", constituting one chapter of the book to be produced.

Obstacles to human rights culture

- **L2.2. Democracy, Justice and Human Rights: Critical Theory Study Group:** During the first semester of 2010, the group would concentrate on the study of the theme "theory and practice

of the radicalization of democracy". Lecturers were to be invited to present seminars to the group on this subject. In the second semester the group proposed to focus on democracy, human rights and education. Negotiations to strengthen the partnership between NEV and The Institute for Social Research of the University of Frankfurt were to continue. Funding for joint seminars, exchange of scholars and internships was to be requested. Preliminary internships have taken place through a post-doctoral period at the University of Frankfurt and at The Institute for Social Research and more are expected to follow.

▪ **L2.3. Quasi longitudinal survey: exposure to violence and socially shared representations and attitudes to justice, rights and punishment and human rights:** Research goals: a) integrate data from the four waves in São Paulo (2001-2008) with that collected in 2010; b) Contextualize national data against compatible data from Latin America collected by World Values Survey and "Latinobarometro." This analysis should result in a book and several articles about how the elements of a culture of human rights and rule of law evolve through time. Other analyses of the same data include: c) analysis of the image of the police through time in São Paulo, for a paper to be published; d) attitudes to punishment through time; e) police image and delegation of the use of force by the police and e) youth victimization and risk of victimization over time.

▪ **L2.4. The fall of homicide in the state of São Paulo: a diagnosis of the magnitude and causes:** Research goals: update the analysis of crime, and social demographic indicators at intra-urban level, using population data from the 2010 Census; integrate this new data GIS (Geographic Information Systems) and statistical packages; identify of outliers; analyze the evolution of homicide by location; extend the analysis of homicide to the Metropolitan Region of São Paulo, Campinas and Santos.

Other goals: Technical cooperation with the São Paulo State Foundation of Data Analysis (Seade), the Metropolitan Planning Company (Emplasa), Coordination of Health Surveillance (COVISA) and the Department of Analysis Coordination and Planning Secretariat of Public Security of the State of São Paulo (CAP/ SP).

Identify areas for qualitative study on the fall of homicide in São Paulo, produce a paper the main determinants of the decline in homicides between 2000 and 2008; producing technical and scientific documents in partnership with the above mentioned institutions.

▪ **L2.5. Analysis of the fall in homicide rate of youth in the city of Sao Paulo, 1996 - 2008:** Research goals: complete the quantitative analysis of the fall in the homicide rates in the city of São Paulo with data from the 2010 Census; refine hypotheses about the fall of homicide through

multivariate analyses. The expected products are: a) a final report; b) publication of one paper. c) collect qualitative data, through focal groups discussions to supplement quantitative study on residents perceptions about the causes for the fall of homicides: is the drop of homicide perceived by the population and if so, which factors and meanings are attributed to this. Focal groups will be carried with professionals and residents of selected regions (with different dynamics of homicide fall). Results will be reported in a paper. Also this study will contribute to the understanding of the relationship between State, citizens and criminality in São Paulo, and will add to the knowledge about the role that democratic guarantees have (or do not have) the people's everyday life people.

Line 3. Monitoring Human Rights

Human Rights: The Present

- **L3.1. 5º National Human Rights Report: Research goals:** a) finish data collection by July 2011, b) finish data analysis by October 2011 and c) write the report. Identify collaborators to write specific chapters: police violence, prisons, torture, children and adolescents, and so forth. The final text will encompass analyses of specific topics, as well as broader problems such as: problems of collecting data on human rights violations, the review of human rights reports in Brazil and in the world, the adoption laws in the area of human rights in Brazil, and the domestic response to rulings by international courts to Brazilian cases.

Human Rights: The Past

- **L3.2. Extra-judicial mechanisms of reparations for victims of Human Rights Violations:** the Latin-American experience: Research goals: analyze key recent events in Brazil- the proposed Truth Commission and the conviction of Brazil by the Inter-American Court of Human Right on the Araguaia case. The two events highlight the weakness of the foundations of a restorative (or transitional) justice in the Brazilian State.
Do a comparative study of legal and judicial instruments that have been applied in other states, such as Argentina, Chile and Peru.

Human Rights: The Future

- **L3.3. Fostering Healthy Early Development:** Research goals: select and train staff to

conduct a pilot in São Paulo in order to accompany 200 adolescents and their children (100 in an intervention group and 100 in a control group); train the team Improved Early Childhood (Primeira Infância Melhor, PIM) of the Health Secretariat of Rio Grande do Sul, in order to implement the home visitation protocol and monitor 200 adolescents and their children (100 in the intervention group and 100 in control group); continue to assist the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) to implement, together with the Municipal Health Secretariat of Rio de Janeiro, a visitation program to promote the healthy development of children of teenagers, living in areas of high vulnerability of the city of Rio de Janeiro.

- **L3.4. Evaluation of the program “Fostering Healthy Early Development”:** Research goals: Complete pre-test instruments and quantitative and qualitative evaluation of the Program.
- **L3.5. Fetzer Research Project on Child maltreatment prevention readiness:** Research goals: Translate and apply final version of interview schedule; test the standardized data treatment programs, carry out statistical analyzes, develop the tools to carry out qualitative analysis , write the preliminary report, review, write the draft final report, review data analysis and write the final country case study.

Other Researches

- **Mapping the Implementation of Recommendations for the World Report on Violence against Children of the UN in South America:** Research goals: Carry out a comparative analyzes of South American countries policies to prevent violence against children after the UN World Report on Violence Against Children and produce recommendations for monitoring.
- **Pre-trial Detention and Anti-Drug Law in Brazil: identifying the obstacles and opportunities for greater efficacy:** Research goals: Finalize data collection with police and members of the criminal justice system. Analyze the data to identify patterns of pre-trial detention sentencing and profile of detainees. Select cases to be followed in the criminal justice system at all stages of the judicial process, identifying the routines and arguments used, comparing them with the rules that regulate. Carry out final analysis of the field data: interviews, observation and data collected from digital archives integrated with the literature review. Present research results to civil police officers, military police officers, public defenders, prosecutors to discuss results and collected suggestions and recommendations. This will be the first step to promote changes, aiming at the improvement of their performance.

1.2. Knowledge Transfer – Dissemination Activities

1.2.1 Websites

- **NEV's website:** Migrate the site to the latest version of Joomla software (1.6), which will allow both deployment of the database grounded on the work of Recovering the History and Collected Data of the NEV, as the navigation and sorting by keywords. We will also invest more in the dissemination of information about NEV's research, publications and events through social networks.
- **Right's Guide (NEV-Citizen):** Update the information and develop a section on urban infrastructure, such as transportation, housing, access to water, electricity and so forth. We will also invest in dissemination of information through social networks
- **Youth rights' guide website:** the project will be implemented.
- **Safety and Citizenship website: promoting violence prevention and transparency in the public security domain:** Next steps in the implementation of this website include: selection of reference documents on training tools, diagnosis tools, intervention tools, assessment tools, and evidence based intervention programs. Translate and adapt documents.
- **Website of the National Institute of Science and Technology INCT-CNPq: Violence, Democracy and Citizen Security:** In partnership with the Forum Brasileiro de Segurança Pública and the agency SeePix the site will be redesigned to meet the needs of the network and to be more user friendly.
- **Website Healthy Childhood:** This website will be regularly updated.
- **Human Rights Observatory Website:** The web-site will be kept in air without further changes.
- **Website of Maps:** All maps will be updated as soon as data for census tracts from the 2010 Census (IBGE) are available.

- **Hot-Site for the International Conference about the Right to Truth:** The web-site will remain online with no new content.
- **Hot-Site Film Festival:** The web-site shall remain online with no new content.
- **Hot-Site 60th Anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR60):** The web-site shall remain online with no new content.
- **Hot-Site Right to Health:** The web-site shall remain online with no new content.
- **Digital database on gross human rights violations:** All cases of police violence will be in digital format (Brazil, decade 1990's and decade 2000's) as well as those on Summary Executions (Rio de Janeiro decade 1990's and decade 2000's). In the first quarter of 2011, the search engine will be available for internal use and that of by registered researchers.

1.2.2. Seminars

External Public

- **International Seminar on home visitation programs to promote early childhood development: challenges for violence prevention:** International seminar with the participation of program managers and researchers to discuss the major challenges faced by home visitation programs to promote healthy child development; identify the good practices developed in middle to low economic development countries in the area; and finally means to overcome challenges such as- the presence of family violence, substance abuse, mental health problems and/or mental disabilities in the family, parents or child carer. The seminar was scheduled to take place at the University of São Paulo in the first semester of 2011.

Internal Public

- **Research Seminar of the National Institute of Science and Technology Violence, Democracy and Citizen Security:** A research seminar of the National Institute of Science and Technology: Violence, Democracy and Public Security scheduled for June.

1.2.3. Others

- **NEV - UNESCO Chair for Human Rights Education:** Keep the partnership with the UNESCO Chair for Education on Human Rights.

1.2.4. Other transfer activities

- **Library:** Develop a regular newsletter open to the public, develop a Thesaurus (controlled vocabulary) on Violence and Human Rights, which will contribute to both the classification of produced content in the institutional site of NEV and the inclusion of our collected data in the Virtual Violence and Health (BVS-VS/CLAVES/ FIOCRUZ).
- **Recovery of the historical material of the NEV / USP:** Organization of the archives, on past research projects developed in NEV-USP.

1.3. Educational activities

Focus was to be given to research activities: no educational activity were planned for this period.

2. QUALITATIVE ANALYSIS OF PROPOSED ACTIVITIES FOR THE PERIOD

2.1. Qualitative analysis of the research activities

As mentioned in previous reports the focus of the research programme is the quality of democracy under construction in the country, in particular the quality of governance. Priority was given to two themes: public security and access to rights. Though the focus is on public security monitoring human rights, in its full meaning remain essential to answer the questions proposed. First, because today, more than ever, it is evident that democracy and human rights are inseparable (Bobbio, 1990)¹. Secondly, because access to economic, social and cultural rights are being increasingly interpreted as key elements for the exercise of democratic rights, for if persons lack access to health and education and of secure livelihood they cannot enjoy their civil and political rights (Beetham, 2002)². Thirdly, democracy demands popular control and political equality. Translated into rights it means the right to express opinions, to be informed, to freely associate, to freely move inside and between countries. Moreover these rights can only be exercised if persons feel free and secure, and if due process prevails. Thus though priority is given to the right to physical integrity: to be protected from violence either by agents of the state, or by others, as key element to enjoy other rights, access to other rights cannot be ignored.

Governance is evaluated both by the actual results it produces in public security and through how this performance is evaluated by the public, and its effects on the development of a human rights culture and in the support for Rule of Law. The broad question that guide the research programme is that about the relation between effective democratic rule of law and a human rights culture in Brazil: "If democracy and a human rights' culture demand the existence of effective democratic Rule of Law, what can be expected for the future of democracy in Brazil?"

To answer this question we proposed that first we identify continuities and changes - what changes, and what does not, in society and in the state: what rule of law emerges, what accountability and responsiveness, and how these affect the public's perceptions and support for a human rights regime, in how far have human rights become behavioral norms, morally and legally binding, against a background of growing urban violence. The questions guiding the study, as mentioned before are:

- Why improvements in economic and social rights, in a context of decline of lethal violence, co-exist with the expansion of organized crime, corruption and gross human rights violations?
- Why, despite improvements, territories dominated by organized crime continue to exist (and even grow), and systemic corruption continues to plague the political, administrative, and judicial spheres?
- Can there be public security without universal access to civil rights, in particular to the right to life?
- What role does impunity play for the development of a human rights culture and in the support of democratic Rule of Law (Morlino, 2004)? What are the pre-conditions for a human rights culture?
- To what extent human rights violations continue to occur in Brazil and who are the groups most at risk?
- To what extent the lack of closure promoted by the general amnesty, a pre-condition for the transition to democracy is an obstacle to effective democratic rule of law? In other words can we have democratic rule of law while denying past violations?

Different research projects contribute with answers to these questions and these are organized under three lines of research: *The implementation (or lack of) of democratic rule of law: public security or insecurity?* b) *Public security, police performance and democratic political culture – the preconditions for a culture of human rights, and c) Monitoring Humans Rights – the present, past and future.*

Research projects vary in the breadth of territory covered: some involve the country, some a few states, some key cities in the country and some still the city and metropolitan region of São Paulo. Some of the projects at national level involve our partners at the INCT Violence, Democracy and Citizen Security (CNPq-FAPESP). The vast majority of projects analyses data from the late 1990's to the present, that is cover the first decade of this century. As such they portray a democracy that could be considered to be well past initial stages of transition to consolidation.

Priority was ascribed to study one type of violence: crimes against life - homicides, for the reasons listed above and because of the large drop in homicide observed in the last decade in Sao

Paulo, and more recently in other key states in Brazil. The transition to democracy made visible the growth of violent crime in the country with rates doubling every decade. Fear of crime became widespread and this fear penetrated all spheres of life, affecting people's attitudes to punishment and human rights, even reducing inhibitions against the violation of basic rights in the case of suspects or those serving sentences for violent crimes. In sum the growth of urban violence was not conducive to a culture of respect for human rights, or for the strong support of democratic rule of law.

Violence became a key issue for citizens. Public debate about the causes of violence intensified and the role of structural causes was highlighted by most academics. The roots for this violence were to be found in the inequalities that accumulated during the military dictatorship and that democracy, so far, had failed to reduce. Though this interpretation did find support in the media, it was not a universal consensus within the public. It was expected that the reduction of inequalities and greater access to social, economic and cultural rights would lead to a the reduction of violence combined with an improved performance of the police and the criminal justice system, while observing respect for rule of law would reduce violent crime.

The connections between structural causes, access or lack of access to rights became more poignant, for this research programme, once economic stability and growth, combined with broad sustained social policies started to reduce some of the inequalities accumulated in the past. The reduction of inequalities took place across the country, economic growth varied, with the poorest regions presenting higher rates than consolidated areas, but the evolution of violent crime did not follow what was expected: a general fall across the country³. On the contrary the picture is far more heterogeneous. Still this diversity provides the study with greater opportunities to explore the links between access to rights and violent crimes.

The three research projects in Sao Paulo on homicide are providing answers to some of the questions posed about: a) the role that access to rights and the reduction of homicide, b) police and criminal justice system performance and the reduction of homicide, c) police and criminal justice system performance and rule of law, d) and the impact of this performance on the support for a culture of respect for human rights. The studies our partners in the INCT are carrying out in their respective states will enrich the answers to these questions, in particular the national study on homicide for the past two decades, as well as that comparing homicide in Brazil, Argentina, Colombia and Mexico (Fundação Oswaldo Cruz, Rio de Janeiro) will broaden the analysis about the relations between access to rights and the violation of the right to life. Hopefully results will also contribute to explain how and why homicide can fall while other forms of violent crime continue to grow (armed robberies, armed robberies followed by death, explosion of cash tills and so forth).

Also surprising is that police use of lethal force remained at high levels throughout the first decade of the 21st century⁴.

Results so far indicate that there is some causal link between improved rates of employment, the reduction of inequalities and the drop in homicide, more so than more investment made in public security⁵. Fear has not been reduced as expected, though the surveys⁶ show that there is a small reduction and actual direct victimization has fallen. One possible explanation is that indirect (witnessed) violence has grown and this could be feeding fear. Results so far indicate that the relations between victimization and attitudes to human rights, law, criminal justice system, use of force, delegation of power to authorities and so forth are not as clear cut as expected.

The experience of victimization seems to be far more complex and lasting than what violence exposure scales have been revealing. The use of time standard time spans (previous 12 months, or 3 months) do not seem suffice when people have had multiple exposures to violence throughout life, moreover when this violence involved life threatening situations either to the person him/herself or that of a close relative. So far data from the surveys suggest that effects of continued exposure to violence need more investigation with new statistical procedures as well as selection of different means to group the variables as well as the use of complementary data from open interviews, also available. Data from the surveys (national and local) reveal a disturbing picture in terms for the development of a culture of respect for human rights: after 27 years of democracy the support for civil and political rights is not as strong as one would expect.

Data from the survey also reveal that similarly to what has been identified in other cultures and contexts, the image the public have of the police is determined by the quality of the contacts that the public have with the police. Thus the performance of the police is not neutral but the basis in which their image is built. The actual performance of the police as measured in the case of homicides⁷ is revealing that not only impunity is very high but that there is clearly discernible reason as to why cases are summarily dropped, or brought to trial or yet why accused are found guilty or acquitted. Omissions and blatant errors were found at all stages of the police inquiry, public prosecutors accusation and during trial. The analyses so far do not indicate that any of the institutions involved exercise their constitutional power of oversight: prosecutors do not appear to oversee police investigations and neither does the judiciary. Thus horizontal accountability seems

to be somewhat weak. It could be argued that since the data for this project refer to cases that took place in the 1990's (1990-1997) that these reflect the past.

Unfortunately, there is strong evidence to the contrary, that they represent an unchanged trend. The study on how the police and the criminal justice system, in Sao Paulo are applying the new anti drug law and its impact in pre-trial detention⁸ arrived at similar conclusion. This new legislation aimed at the separation of penalties to be applied to drug users, from those to be used for people accused of drug trafficking. Drug use is to be approached as a public health problem, and as such, subject to fines and compulsory treatment. Prison sentences and, in particular, pre-trial detention should be applied only to those accused of drug dealing. The study that followed up numerous cases reported by the police over several months during 2010 and 2011, came to similar conclusions to the study on impunity in case of homicide: pre-trial detention and prisons sentences are applied to drug users, omissions and errors are clearly common, access to public defendants faulty and again there are no signs of horizontal accountability.

This far the two studies point to continuities in time of police and criminal justice practices irrespective of the period and type of offense. Considering that there is more visibility and public interest for how the criminal justice system functions and more media concern for police performance, this stability deserves more analytical scrutiny, as it suggests profound resistance to respond to society and to be accountable for their performance.

The analyses of secondary data jeopardized by delay in access to the 2010 Census data. Originally scheduled to be available to researcher by early 2011, this access was postponed to 2012. This prevents the analysis by smallest portion of territory, the census tracts, which in the case of criminal offenses that tend to be heterogeneously distributed across the cities, is absolutely vital. Data from the 2000 Census have been used with projections made for population data but these are fraught with errors.

Various papers based on the preliminary analyses are in course, presently undergoing translation and editing for submission to international and national periodicals. Including the papers on fear and mobility in the city (being submitted to Health and Place), the paper on voters turn out and violence, and one on trust in the police and police performance.

Line 1. The implementation (or lack of) of democratic rule of law: public security or insecurity?

- **L1.1. Violence and Frontiers:** The analysis of secondary data was expanded and consolidated in a report published at the website of the NEV. Papers were presented at relevant academic events in the country – Centro de Estudos Rural e Urbano (CERU), Sociedade Brasileira de Sociologia (SBS) and Associação Nacional de Pós-graduação e Pesquisa em Ciências Sociais (ANPOCS) – and made available to the public. Results reinforce the importance of the border as the locus of analysis, with specificities regarding violence forms, forms of governance and the conditions for the implementation of rule of law and citizenship rights.

Line 2. Public security, police performance and democratic political culture – the preconditions for a Human Rights Culture

- **L2.1. Police investigation and judicial process in São Paulo:** the case of homicides. Qualitative analysis of police and court documents are in progress. All documents of the 197 cases recovered, were read, discussed in research meetings and the data digitalized. This sample includes cases that were dismissed and cases concluded subdivided in the following groups: not indicted, summarily absolved, absolved and convicted.

Given the volume of documental material, a selection was made of cases for qualitative analysis according to: a) cases of unknown authorship; b) cases with clear evidence of summary execution or brutal force ; c) cases involving family conflict that resulted in the death of one or more members, d) cases of unidentified victims (victims "with no history"); e) cases in which apparently important evidence was not explored during police investigations or in the judicial stage such as: neglecting key witnesses or ignoring /not requesting forensic evidence; f) cases of clear technical deficiencies, such as no report of/or no use of technical evidence present in the investigations or prosecutions; g) cases in which the victims are policemen (for which a higher commitment in identifying criminal responsibility was observed); h) cases that complied with all legal requirements and procedures but still were dismissed. Additional criteria were also included for cases in which a conviction and or a not guilty verdict was reached.

Selected cases of investigation and prosecution were fed in the data bases in their integrity, all archival documents in electronic form. This task demanded greater time than originally planned, mainly because most selected criminal cases are lengthy, comprising more than one volume. The organization of documental sources is in its completion phase.

Additional consultations are ongoing. This includes information such as staff numbers, service routines, distribution and internal division of labor, material and human conditions of work, guidelines for performance of professional (non-technical operators and law technicians), evaluation of results. This information is necessary in order to enable more careful assessments of the work environment of the criminal justice system operators and their relationships with the high levels of impunity, as pointed out in previous reports.

No further interviews were conducted. We decided to use the interviews already available, made for the previously completed project (Authoritarian Continuity and Building Democracy, available at www.nevusp.org). These interviews cover the same period of this investigation (1990-1997), were performed with technical operators of the criminal justice system (police officers, prosecutors, judges and defense lawyers) and deal with the functioning of the criminal justice system.

The preparation of a draft final report is underway. This draft contains, aside from the theoretical and methodological goals, a summary of the results achieved by the study of the flow of homicides whether attempted or perpetrated in the criminal justice system. In addition, seminars were held in order to keep the literature review updated and thus the contributions of the literature to the data analysis on the relationship between impunity and confidence in the criminal justice institutions.

Preliminary research results were presented at the II Meeting of the Center for Legal Anthropology (ENADIR / USP, August 2011) and in a paper (Adorno *et al*, Embaralhando fronteiras entre condenados e absolvidos: estudo sobre decisões judiciais e impunidade [Mixing boundaries between convicted and acquitted: a study of judicial decisions and impunity]). This paper is currently under revision for publication.

Preliminary results: the qualitative analysis indicates some directions: more investigation and prosecution of cases in which the identity of the perpetrator was known when the case was initially recorded; preference for witness evidence as opposed to technical evidence, some of which present clear errors or omissions; frequent presence of "the law of silence" among witnesses, which aggravates the precariousness of the production of evidence; little use made of evidence described in investigations and prosecutions; fragile existence of legal reasoning, without identifying the motives and circumstances in which the murders occurred; often reversal of the burden of proof (burden on the defendant and not on the state); problems related to the interpretation of criminal law and criminal procedures, often in violation of constitutional rules, legal interpretation or the judicial culture requirements.

The main conclusion is that there is serious suspicion about the observation of principles of universality, neutrality and autonomy (Bourdieu), which should govern all the judgments and judicial operations. Similar cases end present different procedural outcomes, mixing the

boundaries between dismissed investigations and unindicted processes, between not indicted and summarily absolved, and between convictions and absolutions.

Papers being written: a) on the the influence of community social capital in the disposition of the police to investigate the murders is being entirely rewritten in order to better support the methodology. The study on the relationship between impunity and trust in the criminal justice agencies demanded rigorous methodological refinement, including statistics. It was found that the 16 precincts that comprise the universe presented varied empirical performance (conversion of reported cases in investigative process). It was necessary to construct a typology to analyze the influence of different performance patterns in the belief of citizens (data from surveys) on the ability of the government to provide security and to exercise legal control of law and order. It is in the phase of final statistical analysis, from which a paper for publication in an international journal will be written.

Obstacles for a culture of human rights

- **L2.2. Democracy, Justice and Human Rights: Critical Theory Study Group:** Seminars continued with discussions and presentations during the first semester on the theme of “theory and practice of the radicalization of democracy”. On the second semester, the major theme was that of democracy, human rights and cities. The study group edited a book that was published with the title *Cidades Impossíveis* (Impossible cities). Besides papers (find more on Appendix 1) the group continued the partnership between NEV and The Institute for Social Research of the University of Frankfurt and the first meeting was held in Frankfurt, on July 2010. After a review of the group’s priorities it was decided to focus Seminars activities in order to obtain funding. The internship of the doctoral student Vitor Blotta was successful and that of Brunela Vincenzi, was interrupted due private reasons.

- **L2.3. Quasi longitudinal survey: exposure to violence and socially shared representations and attitudes to justice, rights and punishment and human rights:** The comparative national report concerning the 11 state capitals in 2010 and 10 capitals in 1999 was re-viewed and extended. The data from São Paulo for the five waves of survey was the focus of preliminary joint analysis on: the image of the police, on exposure to violence and attitudes to human rights; social capital and trust in institutions; fear and mobility in the city; fear, social capital and voter turnout; the experience of corporal punishment, victimization and use of violence as means to discipline children; the right to information and to dissent and exposure to violence;

attitudes to democracy as identified in the surveys and in the Latinobarometro. Papers have been prepared and are under final review on all the topics listed above.

The results so far indicate an unstable scenario in terms of attitudes and values conducive to a culture of support for human rights and democracy, in particular amongst those who have been victims of serious violence at a point in time. The analysis of the connection between victimization and the support for tougher punishment, or the disregard for protections against the state abusive use of power is not as clear as initially expected, as is for instance that of the experience of corporal punishment, as children, and the support for the use of force to discipline children or to punish suspects or perpetrators of serious crimes. The field of studies on the effects of exposure to serious violence having concentrated on the effects of such violence in children and adolescents and on the short term effects, has left untouched the question of effects on adults and more so, long terms effects other than trauma and post traumatic syndromes. What is being explored is rather new ground, in which for instance, indirect violence (witnessing) seems on occasions to be produce as serious side effect as having been direct victim of serious violence (eg victim of armed robbery). New statistical treatments of the data are being explored to tease out the potential effects of the different types of victimization. Data from the national survey was contextualized against that of Latinobarometro when compatible and this resulted in a paper on the right to information and demonstration and attitudes of the public to freedom of information and dissent.

▪ **L2.4. The fall of homicide in the state of São Paulo: a diagnosis of the magnitude and causes:** An ecological study of time series characterized the State of São Paulo according to the spatial distribution of certain types of violent crime according with socio demographic profiles. This was the initial stage to test the existence of space-time patterns in the distribution of homicides in the city of São Paulo (MSP). Different patterns of distribution and concentration homicide mortality rates (TMH), were identified between census sectors and census sector and their immediate neighborhood, revealing that degree of continuity of homicide varies in intensity in the city of São Paulo. The study indicates that though there has been an apparently homogeneous and systematic decline in homicides over the last decade, once this phenomenon is analyzed from the perspective of smaller territories (the census tracts) a series of patterns emerge, including the growth of homicide in some sectors. This preliminary study also demonstrated the importance of incorporating analyses of intra-urban dynamics when attempting to identify factors associated with the incidence of homicide.

This analysis has also guided the selection of study areas for the qualitative study on the decline of homicide in São Paulo, 2000 – 2008 with the objective to explore the conceptions that the population have of urban violence and, more specifically, the fall of homicides.

After a lengthy process of evaluation and negotiation, partnerships were formalized between the São Paulo State Foundation for Data Analysis (Seade) and the São Paulo Metropolitan Planning Company (Emplasa) which will allow, respectively, access to deaths by murder (considered deaths from assault with undetermined intent, with firearms, accidents with firearms and by legal intervention), suicides and traffic accidents (trauma, death, etc.), as well as access to digital representations of various units of territory of the Municipality of São Paulo, the Metropolitan Region of São Paulo, Campinas and Santos, associated with a database with data on socioeconomic, environmental and physical mobility.

Also, agreements with COVISA are about to be signed, which will provide access to data of the SIVVA (Surveillance of Violence and Accidents Information System) on the assistance dispensed to victims, the circumstances in which the violence or accident occurred, the evolution of the case and the summary description of what happened. Another agreement is being signed as well with the Military Police of São Paulo, providing access to digitalized criminal offenses recorded through Infocrim (Criminal Information System).

▪ **L2.5 Analysis of the fall in homicide rate of youth in the city of São Paulo, 2000 - 2008:** Final analysis of the data could not be carried out due to the delay in access to data from the 2010 Census. Despite this obstacle, additional analyses (though preliminary) were performed to refine the hypotheses and test some specific assumptions. A descriptive analysis of the fall of homicide in the city of São Paulo revealed that this downward trend is present in several areas of the city irrespective of the degree of social economic inclusion-exclusion, age, gender, race profile of residents. But this analysis also revealed, beside this general trend that the reduction was greater in areas characterized by a high degree of social exclusion, moreover that it was greater amongst the young male population.

It was also observed that the decrease in homicide rate has been contributing to a reduction of inequality in the risk of death from aggression, although exceedingly high mortality rates still persist in areas with worse conditions of life.

Exploratory correlation analyses showed that progress in the reduction of homicide rates in the city of São Paulo is associated with the reduction in the: proportion of youth in the population; unemployment rate; apprehension of firearms, and in the increase in the incarceration-imprisonment rate. Also found were significant correlations with the percentage of the budget the State and in Municipal allocated to Public Security and in the percentage of the budget the State allocated to the Secretariats of Education and Culture, Health and Sanitation.

Though not conclusive, these initial findings point to the importance of multiple factors as determinants of the reduction of violent deaths in the city of São Paulo. Further analyses using multivariate models are necessary and have started. As a first step to test specific hypotheses,

associations between the decrease in homicides and indicators of public security (arrest-incarceration rate - APR), access to firearms (AAF) and police activity (ATP) were analyzed, adjusting them to the changes in the proportion of youth and unemployment rate.

Negative binomial regression models were used. The univariate analysis showed an association between deaths by homicide and TAE and between deaths and ATP. The variable access to firearms was not associated with the reduction in the number of deaths by homicide ($p > 0.05$). After this adjustment, there was a loss of significance in association of both Public Security indicators. In São Paulo the role of public security programs seem to become less important as explanatory factors for the reduction in levels of homicide, after the control of unemployment and the reduction in the proportion of youth in the population. These results reinforce the importance of socio-economic and demographic factors for the reduction of homicide in the city. In connection with this project, the qualitative sector of the research was started, aiming at exploring the perceptions of the population about urban violence and, more specifically, about the causes for the fall of homicides. This component is taking place in three districts of the city with different patterns in the evolution of homicides over time: Jardim Angela, Tiradentes and Cambuci.

Line 3. Monitoring Human Rights

Human Rights: The Present

- **L3.1. National Report on Human Rights:** Updating data on gross human rights violations has been completed. Most of the data analysis was completed and the first draft of the report is nearly finished. Analysts from and outside NEV (around 30 in total) were invited to write about topics familiar to them and to develop an analytical balance of the evolution of the violations during the last decade. Not all analysts have presented their contributions yet, still the final text of the report will be ready early this year (2012), and will be sent to the printers still in the first semester. The analysis so far indicate that gross human rights violations in Brazil persist, possibly on a large scale, but precise quantification is still lacking due to insufficient access to data. The most vulnerable groups to violations, as far as available data allows to identify continue to be: the young, the poor (in particular of homicides, and police violence), women (domestic violence), children (physical abuse), Brazilians Afrodescendants (victims of racial prejudice), and so forth.

- **L3.2. Thirty years of police violence:** A national and international literature review was carried out covering the historical roots of Police violence in Brazil and this is informing the analysis of the data on the image of the Police and its legitimacy.

Human Rights: The Past

- **L3.3. Mechanisms of extra-judicial reparation for victims of human rights violations: the Latin American experience:** In 2011, an analysis was made regarding the trial of ADPF 153 by the Brazilian Supreme Court (STF), which deals with the Brazilian Amnesty law in comparison with the judgment of the Inter-American Court of Human Rights (IACHR) on the Araguaia case. The analysis revealed the dissonance between the implementation of transitional justice in Brazil and its understanding by the Inter-American human rights system.
- **L3.4. Measuring the Effectiveness of Human Rights Campaigns in Latin America: the role of the Organization of American States, Inter-American Commission on Human Rights, 1970-1985:** The Project is suspended due to the lack of access to the documents.
- **L3.5. Citizen Security and Human Rights in the Americas, and Juvenile Justice in the Americas:** The Report Citizens Security and Human Rights was released by the Inter-American Commission of Human Rights. The report shows that public security policies implemented in many states of the region have, in general terms, disagree from international human rights standards, and that often authorities have resorted to the illegal and arbitrary use of force in the name of crime prevention and control. The report highlights that these policies have failed to attend to society's demands for public security when based on harsher punishment, fewer procedural guarantees, and when treating adolescents accused of criminal offenses as adults.

Human Rights: The Future

- **L3.6. Fostering healthy early development:** An International Seminar on Home Visitation took place between the 9th and the 10th of May. The Seminar Preventing Violence and Promoting Child Development, brought together over 250 people with the presence of renowned international speakers (full program appended). Participants came from the Americas: USA, Chile, Peru, Colombia, Cuba, Venezuela, Jamaica and Brazil and from Africa: South Africa, Mozambique and Angola. A book is being prepared based on the contributions. Funds transferred by WHO have allowed the pre-testing of the program using non-expert (lay) visitors. This has allowed the necessary adjustments in terms of training and supervision of non-expert (lay) visitors. The site Healthy Childhood continues online and is updated periodically. During 2011, 3272 visits were made to the site, with 20,715 pages viewed. In addition to the site, the content developed by the program has been adapted for a CD-ROM version diagrammed for a printed publication. This experience continues to be exchange with the staff of the Improved Early Childhood Program

(IMP), in Rio Grande do Sul, and to assist the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) in the city of Rio de Janeiro.

▪ **L3.7. Evaluation of the program: Fostering healthy early development:** In the first semester of 2011, the pre-test of evaluation instruments was finished. This evaluation took place at the Samuel B. Person Health Center, located in the Butantã (after formal authorization). Contact and the application of the tools provided were made with eight adolescents and their children in different stages of life: a) two teenagers during pregnancy (from 13 weeks of gestation); b) two teenagers in the postpartum period (30 days postpartum); c) two teenagers with 12 months children. The pre-test, revealed the need for adjustments of the instruments.

The implementation of the program on the originally planned scale of 100 adolescents, which is essential to enable the evaluation of program's effectiveness, has not been started. The implementation activities continue, but on a smaller scale (given the lack of resources for implementation on a larger scale), which is insufficient to execute the proposed assessment.

▪ **L3.8. Fetzer Research Project on Child maltreatment prevention readiness:** Data collection, revision of data treatment procedures, preliminary and final data analysis were all finished in 2011. Sixty one key professionals at the Ministry of Health, Justice, Human Rights, UN agencies in Brazil, Pediatrics Association, Medical Board, experts on child affairs and so forth were interviewed. The final version of the comparative international study is under way as that depends on international collaboration by March 2012. From the final report, an executive summary will be sent to local authorities and professionals in the field, in order to disseminate the results.

This research contributes partially with the research program of the Center. It is known that children are an extremely vulnerable population group and that the family is often responsible for serious violations of their rights, endangering their physical integrity and their right to a healthy development. It is also known that the exposure to violence at this stage of development has serious long-term consequences, inevitably posing financial costs to the State (either health care for this vulnerable population, social assistance or legal matters) and social costs in general (such as juvenile delinquency, more family violence, drug abuse, damage to mental health, among others).

Violence against children is therefore a relevant issue for democracies and has had great attention from international agencies. Given these considerations, the Fetzer project is aimed at identifying which resources (whether financial, technical or human) and which public policies are being implemented in order to prevent this phenomenon called prevention readiness, *i.e.*, which

measures are being taken to protect one of the most vulnerable groups of the population. The answer is alarming: even though the social damage caused by abuse it is a consensus, very little is being done in order to solve the problem. It is known, even without precise studies, that Brazil has high rates of violence against children, but has no strategy or policy to combat them. Undoubtedly, while neglected, children are denied their full citizenship, be it in the immediate consequences of violence or by long-term consequences, creating thus a social environment which is favorable to new violations, forming a vicious circle. Comparative papers are being prepared to disseminate the data from all six nations (Brazil, Macedonia, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, Malaysia, and China) covered in this study.

Other Research

- **Mapping the Implementation of Recommendations for the World Report on Violence against Children of the UN in South America:** data collection tools were developed to be applied specifically to each of the groups surveyed, namely: government, civil society organizations and experts, and groups of children and adolescents, the ten countries studied (Argentina, Brazil, Bolivia, Chile, Colombia, Ecuador, Paraguay, Peru, Uruguay, Venezuela). In addition, a bibliographic and documental database on the theme of childhood and youth in the region was developed. This informed a report about the political and legal frameworks and administrative procedures to guarantee the rights of children and adolescents in the continent (to be published), which will be released by the Global Movement for Children and in the Workshop of the Special Representative of UN Secretary General for the issue of Violence against Children, Marta Santos Pais.

- **Pre-trial Detention and Anti-Drug Law in Brazil: identifying the obstacles and opportunities for greater efficacy:** The study involved 70 interviews with operators of criminal justice; systematization of data collected by the Police Department Investigations – DIPO; analysis of cases; workshop with the operators of the criminal justice system (whose comments were transcribed and inserted in the analysis of the research); final research report.

The survey results, indicate a certain pattern in drug trafficking arrests, mostly by the military police while in regular/routine street patrols. In general only one person is arrested, the only witness is the police authority who has made the arrest; the average amount of drug apprehended is 66.5 grams; the accused has no defense while at the police station; the arrest for drug trafficking does not involve violence; the defendants represent a specific part of the population, namely men, between 18 and 19 years old, with brown and black skin color, with poor schooling (up to eight grade) and

no criminal record; the defendants are eventually represented by the Public lawyers; accused they wait for trial in jail; sentences are usually under five years.

The interviews revealed that: there are constant conflicts between the civil police and the military police. Also that it is common the mutual dissatisfaction between workers from the different of institutions that comprise the Criminal Justice System; respondents attribute to drug users the growth of drug trafficking; there is no consensus on the meaning of each criterion provided by the law to distinguish between the articles 28 and 33 possession for use and traffic; most operators perceive pre-trial detention as necessary in for trafficking crimes; there is a perception that the crime of drug trafficking is of a serious and heinous nature.

The main consequence of this policy is a large mass of young people getting a police criminal record and the stigmas produced by prison. The justice system cannot ignore the social and cultural consequences of such policies. Furthermore, the data indicate that there were no major changes in the pattern of activity of the police in combating drug trafficking with respect to the period when the previous drug law was in force (Law 6.368/76).

With regard to pre-trial arrest, it is possible to approach the issue from the perspective of the right of defense, since in some cases there is not even a request for provisional freedom. In this sense, two constitutional guarantees are united - the right of defense and the presumption of innocence - to show that there are problems regarding the respect for individual rights and guarantees.

Though conflicts and dissatisfactions between operators of the institutions were identified their actual practice indicate the opposite: there is little disagreement on the work of organizations when it comes to appreciate and judge a crime. What is shown, from the police performance to the trial by court judges, is a uniformity of how they understand the facts, with a lack of questioning and a low quality of evidence. When considering the necessary aspects for a judgment founded on the law, this issue gains importance, since it is possible to identify that the institutions responsible for law enforcement do not monitor each other, leading to a continuous contact with the excesses of the repressive apparatuses and violations of fundamental rights, to which no due attention was given. If the lack of punishment encourages impunity and bring discredit to courts, the argument must also be made that disproportionate or unreasonable punishment also generates mistrust in justice and undermines the basic values of democratic rule of law and the legitimacy of its institutions.

▪ **Juvenile Justice under Brazilian Democracy: Anthropological Study of Incarcerated Youth:** The principal objective of the postdoctoral research is to complete a critical analysis of empirical research gathered through nearly three years of anthropological fieldwork at an institution for the internment of adolescent offenders in northeastern Brazil. At first examining practices of institutional record keeping and the ways these contribute to constructing inmates and their

perceived potential for resocialization and then critically examine the ways that processes of social and economic neoliberalization within Brazil's project to consolidate democratic governance have participated in allocating values to the lives of citizens.

In this regard a paper on the work contemplating the relationship between street children and crime in northeastern Brazil has been submitted to the journal *Cultural Anthropology*. A new article "Death and the Confirmation of Social Life" has been written and is currently under review. An essay provisionally titled "Almost Killed for a Few Small Bills" has been submitted to the journal *Granta* for review. Currently, it is being elaborated an article that further examines both the formation of systems of political and social accounting in which some lives are accorded more value than others, and the disjuncture in the ways that members of different social classes attribute value to human life and to consumer goods.

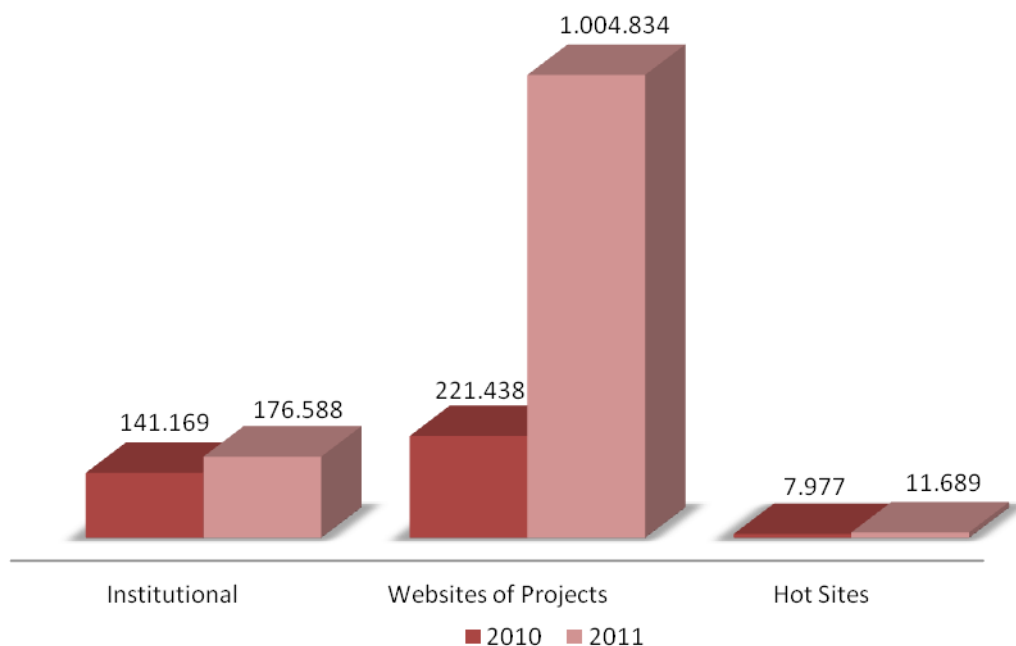

Line 1. The implementation (or the lack) of the democratic rule of law: public security or insecurity?

- **L1.1. Violence and Frontiers:** Nothing to note

Line 2. Public Security, police performance and democratic political culture – the preconditions for a Human Rights Culture

- **L.2.1. Police investigation and judicial process in São Paulo:** Nothing to note

Obstacles to a Human Rights Culture

- **L2.2. Democracy, Justice and Human Rights: Critical Theory Study Group:** Nothing to note.

- **L.2.3. Quasi longitudinal survey: exposure to violence and socially shared representations and attitudes to justice, rights and punishment and human rights:** Difficulties refer to the complex nature of the effects of exposure to violence, the scarce literature on effects of this exposure on adults through life course and the cross-sectional nature of the data which limit the identification of causal relations.

- **L.2.4. The fall of homicides in the state of São Paulo: a diagnosis of the magnitude and causes:** Difficulties of access to needed data was the main obstacle to the achievement of the objectives proposed in 2011. However, the partnerships recently established will allow the achievement of the goals in 2012.

- **L2.5. The fall of homicide in the state of São Paulo: a diagnosis of the magnitude and causes:** The delay in the disclosure of data from the IBGE Census for 2010 has limited the quantitative analysis.

Line 3. Human Rights Monitoring

Human Rights: The present

- **L3.1. National Report on Human Rights:** The great challenge for conducting research in the area of human rights violations remains the lack of official data. This includes both lack of access to existing data and lack of systematic disaggregated data on key topics. An example of this obstacle is the efforts to find data on police brutality, whose magnitude in Brazil is impossible to measure. The state of São Paulo figures as a possible exception of this problem.

Human Rights: The Past

- **L. 3.2. Mechanisms of extra-judicial reparation for victims of human rights violations: the Latin American experience:** An obstacle was the differences in understanding given to the right to truth and in particular the conflicts between international and national laws concerning this issue.

Human Rights: The Future

- **L3.5. Fostering healthy early development:** Nothing to note
- **L.3.6. Fetzer Research Project on Child maltreatment prevention readiness:** an obstacle encountered is the development of strategies , to improve the readiness to prevent child maltreatment in the country, is the lack of studies on on child development, on child maltreatment and thus to transfer knowledge about such key issues.

Other Researches

- **Mapping the Implementation of Recommendations for the World Report on Violence against Children of the UN in South America:** Identification of primary and secondary sources in each of the researched countries, as well as the elaboration of the default-instruments that would be applicable in every country, enabling the accomplishment of a comparative regional analysis.
- **Pre-trial Detention and Anti-Drug Law in Brazil: identifying the obstacles and opportunities for greater efficacy:** The access to data from the criminal justice system was one of the challenges encountered by the research, aside from the difficulty of reaching specific areas of the police and of the criminal justice system.

4. POTENTIAL PROBLEMS / BOTTLENECKS

NEV headquarters were moved in mid 2011 as result of the need to vacate areas for upgrade. Though present installations are better than the old ones, the move was defined within short notice and this did affect day to day work. Also the building that is presently occupied required adaptations and for a while the team had to overlap with builders and suplyers, again conditions less than ideal.

5. OBJECTIVES TO BE ACHIEVED IN 2012

5.1. Research

Line 1. The implementation (or lack of) of the democratic rule of law, public security or insecurity?

- **L1.1. Violence and Frontiers:** a) identification of the rule of law or un-rule of law in the frontiers using the model suggested by Hagopian (2005) to identify quality of democracy:

I- *Freedom and rights:* indicators- degree of civil liberties and political, freedom of press: economic censorship, threats to journalists, killings of journalists; access to information: effective right of access to public data and habeas data; and rights of prisoners: rate of imprisonment, pre-trial rates, proportion of pre-trial prisoners in relation to those serving sentences and prison overcrowding.

II- *Access to rule of law:* indicators- homicide rate; comparative governance rate; public opinion on rule of law; rate of judges per 100,000 residents; rate of public defendants per 100,000 residents; punishment for the killing of peasants and rural workers, trade union leaders, lawyers and religious leaders in rural and urban conflicts; gender equality and fairness of the legal system towards the indigenous population;

III- *Horizontal accountability:* qualitative analysis of the relations between the Executive, the Legislative and the Judicial branches, the presence of independent Accounting offices and Public Prosecution, at state and federal levels. Here the analysis will focus two events: the aftermath of the Parliamentary Inquiry on Drug Trafficking for Acre and Rondonia and the Federal Police investigation on corruption involving the legislative, judiciary and the state government in Rondonia.

IV- *Equality and Inequality* indicators- *level of income inequality* (Gini coefficient, share of income of top percent, percent living below poverty); *educational opportunities and educational inequality* (primary education completion rate, secondary education completion rate, and average years of education for 20 to 25 years old, according to income level; and adult [15+] illiteracy); *health inequality* (infant mortality rate per 1000 live births; child sub-nutrition; life expectancy); maternal mortality and *gender inequality in political representation* (percentage of women in the Legislative).

V- *Competition* measured by public financing for political campaigns; distribution of seats in the Legislative for the different political parties; competition between political parties.

VI-*Responsiveness*; trust in government; trust in parties; trust in democracy; importance of voting; credibility of politicians; satisfaction with how the state is governed from national opinion polls.

VII-*Participation* indicators: registered voters as percent of voting-age population; voter turn –out in relation to registered voters and per capita gross domestic product.

VIII- *Political representation*_indicators: competitiveness between political parties; government formation follows the preferences of citizens, express the ideology and opinion of the electorate when defining public policies and legislation; and responsiveness; and party political programs express the citizens preferences.

Line 2. Public safety, police performance and democratic political culture - the preconditions for a Human Rights Culture

- **L2.1. Police investigation and judicial process in Sao Paulo:** the case of homicides: a) finish qualitative analysis, b) continued internal seminars for the refinement of the analysis of results; c) final report with all results in all stages of the flow of the criminal justice system; d) conclusion and preparation of papers on (i) impunity and confidence in the criminal justice institutions (see description below), (ii) social capital and impunity, (iii) Study on judgments and impunity (first version completed in phase review) (iv) Law, order and impunity in contemporary Brazil (proposal approved for international anthology), (v) paper on methodological issues arising from the research process.

Obstacles to human rights culture

- **L2.2. Democracy, Justice and Human Rights: Critical Theory Study Group:** Nothing to note

- **L2.3. Quasi Longitudinal Survey:** exposure to violence and socially shared representations and attitudes to justice, rights and punishment and human rights: Continue and expand statistical treatment of the data on the national survey as well as on the four waves in São Paulo, as well as the treatment of secondary data. Contextualize this data against qualitative data collected over the 1990's to identify continuities and changes in the support for democracy and

human rights in a context of growth of urban violence, since if homicide fell in São Paulo, other violent crimes continued to grow.

- **L2.4. The fall of homicide in the state of São Paulo:** a diagnosis of the magnitude and causes Scan, consist of, systematize and integrate the databases of morbidity, mortality and crime gathered from the partners. Integrate the new databases with digital representations of the areas of study and with data from the Census of 2010 (micro database). Identify robust, appropriate and efficient statistical and geo-statistical techniques to analyze the variability of homicides and their constraints, both within and between-regions. Describe and interpret the results and compare them with the literature.

- **L2.5. Analysis of the decline in homicide rate of young people in São Paulo, 2000 - 2008:** Quantitative study: statistical analyses completed after the release of 2010 Census data by the IBGE. Qualitative study: complete the fieldwork in the three districts selected for the study, analyse the collected material, write a final report to be released at the site of the NEV, bringing together the quantitative and qualitative analysis, and writing specific articles about the results.

Line 3. Human Rights Monitoring

Human Rights: The Present

- **L3.1. National Report on Human Rights:** In 2012 edit contributions from guest analysts, write the final report, review and send to the printer. The contents of the report will also be available on the NEV's website.

Human Rights: The Past

- **L3.2. Mechanisms of extra-judicial reparation for victims of human rights violations: the Latin American experience:** The project ended in 2011.

Human Rights: The Future

- **L3.3. Fostering healthy early development:** In 2012, we will continue the pre-tests of the visits by lay specialists to analyze the feasibility and the results achieved through this approach.

Efforts will be made to raise funds to implement the proper pilot intervention with an experimental and a control group.

- **L3.4. Evaluation of the program: fostering healthy early development:** Pending the implementation of the pilot project.

- **L3.5. Fetzer Research Project on Child maltreatment prevention readiness:** Preparation of papers for international and national dissemination: Joint publications (all research teams: a) global publication on project; b) special issue or special section in journal on six country reports with introduction and conclusion (perhaps in WHO Bulletin or Child Abuse and Neglect); c) publication on difficulty in shifting people's thinking from protection to prevention; d) on readiness and attitudes of representatives of different sectors: government, nongovernment; e) gender and child maltreatment prevention; f) the disconnection between the field of child maltreatment and its consequences and the field of healthy development; g) current programmes in six countries and their characteristics; h) "Experts without knowledge".

Others Researches (outside the main research lines)

- **Pre-trial detention and Anti-Drug Law in Brazil: identifying the obstacles and opportunities for greater efficacy:** Dissemination of research data, attempt to awareness about the issue addressed by the research, achieving a Seminar by the Criminal Justice Network, composed of several human rights organizations, whose theme will be pretrial detention.

- **Juvenile Justice under Brazilian Democracy: Anthropological Study of Incarcerated Youth:** For the year to come, it is intended to complete this second article, now in progress, on the ways that values are ascribed to consumer goods and particular human lives within Brazil's contemporary neoliberal economy and within the context of youth crime in the northeast of the country. Then, complete an article contemplating the ways that bureaucratic operatuses administering juvenile justice in Brazil contribute to producing the realities of crime and criminality they are ostensibly intended to merely record.
